

### Learning Exploration: Our Coastline

We know our children love to explore the local area with their families. We also know that our local area has a rich coastline, and so we will be working on pupils' individual targets through provision linked to sand and water, pebbles and dinosaurs.



### Hook into learning:

Children will have opportunities to work on their digging, sandcastle building and fishing skills in sand and water.

### Journey through the exploration

As we think about the 3 foci for this topic, children will have opportunities to explore how water moves through different containers, how sculptures can be made using prints of shells and pebbles and finally how things can be hidden and then discovered in sand.

### Linked subjects

Through this exploration, learning will be linked where appropriate, including in the following subjects:

- Knowledge and understanding of the world
- Expressive arts and design (sculpture)

The following subjects will be taught discretely during this half term:

- Maths: shape, height and counting.
- Food: social skills and language skills, specifically following instructions.
- PSED: self-care and independence, relationships and others and feelings, behaviours and morals.
- Physical development

Children will continue to work on their individualised targets based on the outcomes in their EHCPs, termly SEND plans and any reports from outside agencies.



### Writing

Children will be encouraged to work on their fine motor skills and, when appropriate, develop their formation of letters with a degree of accuracy.

Children will have a themed story of the week read to them each day.

### Maths

Children will explore:

- Counting
- Height
- 2d shapes including pattern making
