
















This week in the nursery some of our provision will include:

If you would like to support your child to develop their understanding and use of the above vocabulary, here are some suggestions for you to try:

- Sorting size, weight, length or objects at home such as vegetables or toys.
- Give your children some cups/jugs in the baths to explore capacity
- Discuss the height/length of things around you such as buildings or other things you may see on your walks.
