Each week in the nursery we will focus on a different concept. Our learning inputs, books, songs and provision within the nursery environment are carefully planned to support the development of the focus concept.



It is our aim to use the language linked to the concept as much as possible throughout the week whilst talking and playing with your child so that their understanding and use of new vocabulary widens.

This week our concept in the nursery is: **Colour**

The concept language for **colour** is:

Level 1	Level 2	Level 3	Level 4
Blue Green red	black white yellow	orange pink purple	dark/er Light/er plain striped

In the nursery this week we will be reading:

This week in the nursery some of our provision will include:

- Animal sorting
- Colour hunt
- Collage and painting animal stripes
- Painting flags
- Making crowns

Also in the nursery this week:

Maths	Add and subtract a number from 5, including 0.
Phonics	The children will be focusing on the sound, looking at words such as hat, hug, hot, house, horse, head, hammer, helicopter

If you would like to support your child to develop their understanding and use of the above vocabulary, here are some suggestions for you to try:

- When out and about see if you can spot different colours and stripes.
- Colour hunt – finding things at home and matching/sorting the colours.
- Reading stories about colours.
