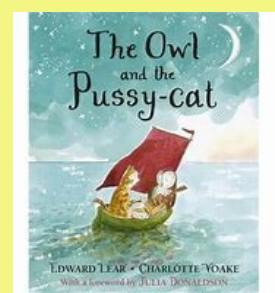
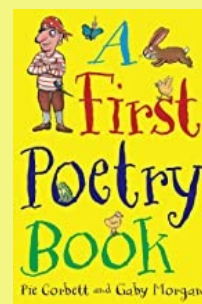
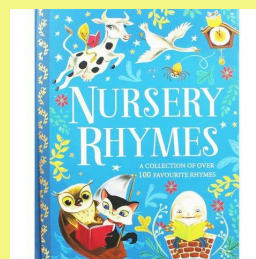
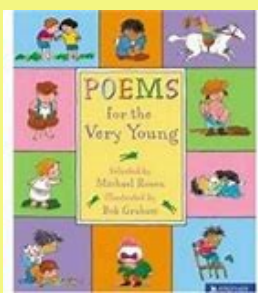
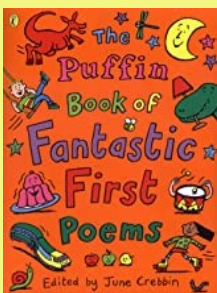


The Libby App allows you to access online texts free with a library card.

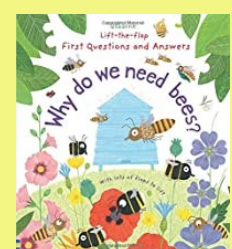
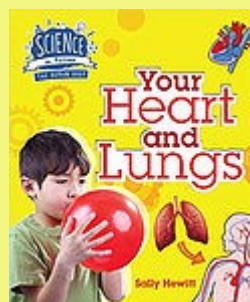
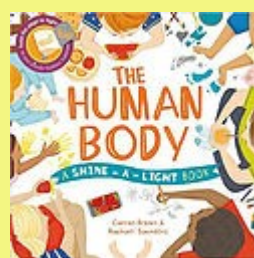
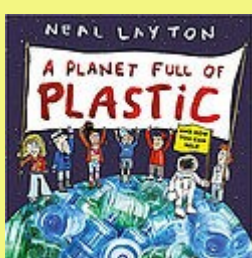
To develop their reading skills, the children in year 1 are encouraged to read phonetically decodable texts that are matched to the letters and sounds programme that they are taught in class. Children will be provided with a levelled home reading book which is matched to their letters and sounds phase. We also have a variety of alternative phonetically decodable texts available in the library which the children can choose independently.
