If you allow your child to use the game, make sure you check out these top tips from the O2 Guru to keep them as safe as possible:

- Explore the game with you child and talk about the content and if it worries them.
- Turn off the voice chat to protect them from inappropriate language.
- Discuss with your child about things they share online and what is appropriate.
- Make yourself famialr with the parental controls (see below for guidance)

How do I set up parental restrictions?



Sometimes innocent searches online bring up not so innocent results. Use parental controls to keep your children safe.

Parental controls can help prevent your child from seeing harmful content. Parental controls are also available to help you to:

- plan what time of day your child can go online and how long for.
- stop them from downloading apps they're too young for.
- manage the content different members of the family can see.

The NSPCC has teamed up with O2 to provide online safety support to keep young people safe (and parent's minds at ease).
